

# Hazmat Cargo Security Web Seminar

## You Must Have A Security Plan If You Ship or Transport:

- Any hazardous materials in quantities that require placards, or
- Any hazardous materials in bulk packaging equal to or greater than 3,500 gallons, or
- Small quantities of high hazards such as poison gas, radioactives, and explosives, or
- Micro organisms and toxins regulated by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Under HM-232, the DOT requires site-specific security plans and more — Shippers must identify hazmat security risks, determine appropriate standards, develop and implement a security plan, and train hazmat employees on elements of the plan.
