## Ensure Compliance with New York Mandates



Annual training is mandatory for individuals who manage hazardous waste in New York. Fines for non-compliance are now as high as \$55,000 per day/per violation. Ensure your site is in compliance by attending this hands-on workshop on New York's Hazardous Waste Regulations. ### Annual Training is Required by Law

Annual and update training is required by law at 6 NYCRR 373-1.1(d)(1)(iii)(c)(5) and 373-3.2(g), and 40 CFR 262.34(a)(4) and 265.16. Training is required for all facility personnel who work at or oversee the operations of a facility where hazardous waste is generated or managed. Generators must have a written training plan and training records for all personnel. This includes contractors.

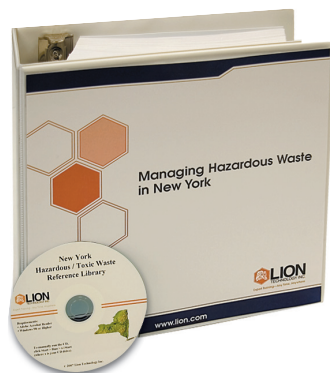
- Authorities and jurisdiction, responsibilities, liabilities, NYCRR regulatory structure, and adoption of the Federal rules
- What are solid and hazardous wastes in NY, listings and characteristics, wastes containing PCBs, used electronics, and C7 notification
- Determining land disposal restrictions, New York vs. Federal rules
- How to manage universal waste, mercury-containing equipment and lamps, used oil, rags, and other special waste
- Counting waste toward generator status, and DSHM container and packaging weight policy
- How to accumulate, store, and manage hazardous waste on site and in environmentally sensitive areas
- Rules for emergency preparedness and prevention, contingency plans, incident notifications, and release reporting
- Off-site shipping, manifest instructions, tracking and discrepancies, "one trip rule," LDR notifications and certifications
- Recordkeeping and reporting, training documentation, and the hazardous waste reduction plan
